ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF VITAMINS FOR THE WORLD, INC.

ARTICLE III

THIS CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically, this corporation will provide nutritional relief to the poor, distressed, and disadvantaged in developing countries such as the Dominican Republic and Sudan. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) ob behalf of any candidate for public office.

UPON the DISSOLUTION of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for the a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income of the assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as described in Internal Revenue Code 509(a), 1) corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner so that in will not become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provision of any later tax laws. 2) The corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any latter federal tax laws, 3) the corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws, 4) the corporation will not make any investments in a manner that would subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws, and 5) the corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
