ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF



INDIANTOWN COMMERCE & TECHNOLOGY PARK PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the INDIANTOWN COMMERCE & TECHNOLOGY PARK PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida corporation not for profit, adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

FIRST: Amendment(s) adopted:

Article II is amended to change the purpose of the corporation as follows:

ARTICLE II Purposes

ILICO B LLC, a Florida limited liability company, its successors and assigns, collectively referred to herein as "Declarant", is developing certain property in Palm Beach Martin County, Florida, known as "Indiantown Commerce & Technology Park" (hereinafter the "Park").
