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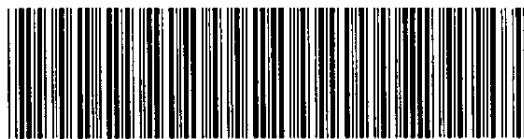

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FAMILIES RESTORING THE  
HOMEFRONT, Inc**

**ARTICLE I-NAME**

The corporation shall be known as Families Restoring the Homefront, Inc.

**Article II-Principle Office**

912 Miles Street  
Tallahassee, Florida 32304

**Article III-Purpose**

A. Families Restoring the Homefront, Inc is a community-based, parent support group designed to address the needs of single parents, as well as parents of "at-risk" children. Through information and education we believe that the quality of relationships can be improved within the family unit, developing healthy family relationships within the community being served.

B. The organization, to achieve these purposes will offer educational and developmental tools through workshops, group discussions, films, reading materials and field trips.

C. The organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes; the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

D. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of eh organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) OF THE Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

# **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FAMILIES RESTORING THE HOMEFRONT Inc**

## **Article IV Distribution of Assets**

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

## **Article V-Board of Directors/Advisors**

A. Families Restoring the Homefront, Inc Board of Directors/Advisors consist of professional volunteers from the community as well as parents of families most affected by the board's recommendations. The Board will meet every 3 months to serve as a liaison between Families Restoring the Homefront Parenting Group and the community served.

B. The purpose and role of the board is strictly advisory. Input from the board is solicited and important, however, it is viewed strictly as recommendations. The board has no authority to revise policies and procedures or to make administrative decisions, based on internal decisions, based in part on board recommendations as well as community needs in addressing "families at risk"

C. The function of the board recommendations rest primarily in 5 areas; Community Needs Assessment, Learning Modules and Course Contents, Community Public Relations, Equipment, Facilities and Community Resources.

**ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION OF FAMILIES RESTORING THE

**Article VII Dissolution of Corporation**

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization(s) under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 ( or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated and operated exclusively for such purposes.
