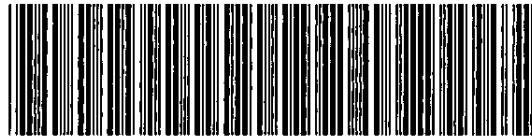

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Sunny Hills Songs of the South Music & Arts Festival, Inc.

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 3941 Gates Avenue, Chipley, Florida 32428.

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: To host an annual music and arts festival celebrating the native culture of Northwest Florida through music, arts & crafts, and storytelling.

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV – MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be in accordance with the By-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII – EARNINGS AND ACTIVITIES

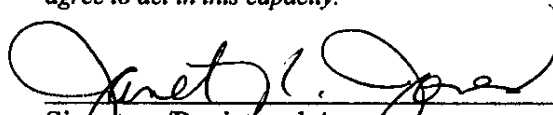
No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall

be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

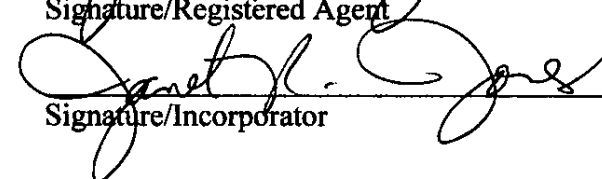
ARTICLE XI – DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax doe, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
