The name of the corporation shall be the "FLORIDA POLICE COMBAT LEAGUE, INC."

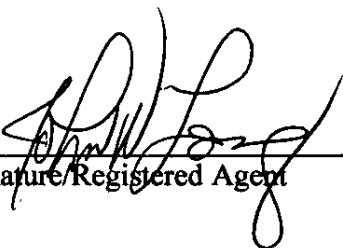
