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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION for

(a corporation not for profit)

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1 - Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Freedom Independent Drivers Association, Inc., a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE II - Principal office and mailing address

The principal office and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III - Purpose(s)

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

To act as a cab drivers' association — Our mission is to achieve common goals and standards for improved services and to be more effective as a collective bargaining unit.

ARTICLE IV - Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

The Board of Directors shall be elected as set forth in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII - Revenue

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be allocable to its members, Directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. The corporation shall not in any way, directly or indirectly, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, or participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170©(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

ARTICLE IX-Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, The Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the payings of the corporation in such

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manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501@(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity
