ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)RETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

Article of Incorporation of the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of <u>The State of Florida</u>, do hereby certify:

Article 1: The name of the Corporation shall be Florida Learning Institute Inc.

Article 2: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is 1201 West Cypress Creek Road, Suite 130 in the City of <u>Fort Lauderdale</u>, Broward County.

Article 3: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes as providing social and related health services to needy residents of Broward County, providing educational, recreational and rehabilitative services to the youth and young people of Broward County, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 4: The Directors were appointed and approved by voice vote at the first meeting of the corporation. Any additional Directors must be elected by unanimous vote of the initial directors listed below.

Article 5: The names, titles and addresses of the persons who are the initial directors of the corporation are as follows:

Article 6: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 7: The Annual Accounting Period of the corporation shall be August 1st. to July 31st.

Article 8: The Board of Directors of Florida Learning Institute Inc, Inc reserve the right to appoint qualified competent professionals to be responsible for the day to day operations of the organization and to provide remunerations as the board deem appropriate.

Article 11: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 12: The Parent Body of this corporation shall be Trinity Ministries Worship Center, Inc (Formerly Trinity New Testament Ministries, Inc.) an IRS 501(c)(3) approved organization.
