Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name and address of this principal corporation is In His Arms Ministries Inc.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 6331 S.W. 5th Street, Margate, Florida 33068 in Broward County. The organization is organized pursuant to the FLORIDA Non-Profit Corporation Code.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation Law, for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self-sufficiency. ARTICLE IV
