ARTICLE 1 NAME

SECRETARY OF STAIL TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The name of this corporation shall be: Volunteer USA Foundation, Inc. The principal address of this corporation shall be: 516 North Adams Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32301.

ARTICLE II ENABLING LAW

This corporation is organized pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which this Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific and educational, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and the Regulations promulgated thereunder, being principally to help strengthen societal fabric in important ways. Volunteer USA Foundation, Inc. will incubate and grow effective research-based programs that will improve the quality of life of those served. The goal is to work with new and existing nonprofits whose passion is to make their community a better place through volunteerism, and educational programs. Volunteer USA Foundation, Inc. will have national presence with Florida serving as its headquarters. Toward that end, the Corporation shall be empowered to:

- To have and exercise any and all powers conferred upon corporations, both for profit and not for profit, under the statutes of the State of Florida, provided, however, that this Corporation is not empowered to engage in any activity that in itself is not in furtherance of its purposes as set forth above;
- Other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation notwithstanding, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be undertaken, by: a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or b) a corporation to which contributions are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any other corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law;
- 3. Notwithstanding the powers and purposes enumerated in these Articles, the Corporation shall be restricted as follows: no part of the net earning of

the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Board member, other member, officer, or other associate of representative of the Corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation in effecting on or more if its purposes), and no Board member shall be assigned other corporation's assets upon dissolution of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV TERM

The period of the duration of this Corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to the law.

ARTICLE VI OUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The qualifications of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, the authorized number, and the manner of admission of directors to this Corporation, the different classes of membership if any, the privilege of voting and other rights and privileges of directors, the liability of directors and/or dues or assessments, and the method of collection theron in the termination and transfer of membership, shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of this Corporation.

ARTICLE VII MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

A. <u>Board of Directors</u>: The powers of this Corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by the Board of Directors. The number of Directors herein provided for shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation, providing that there shall never be less than five Board of Directors. B. <u>Employment of Staff</u>: the Board of Directors may retain staff for the purpose of conducting day-to-day management and supervision of Corporate affairs, consistent with policies and directions set by Board, and with the qualifications and provisions outlined by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE XII NONDISCRIMINATION

No person shall be denied membership, association with, participation in the programs of, or other involvement with the business and services of the Corporation on the basis of race, creed, national origin, age sex, handicap, or religion.
