ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CRM Help Center, Inc.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617. Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation AHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be CRM Help Center, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 715 SW 7th Terrace, Dania Beach, Florida 33004, Broward County, Florida.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

A) Community Multipurpose Social Service Center

To establish and maintain a faith-based, multipurpose, not for profit social service organization in the State of Florida. To establish, maintain and conduct community-based social and support services for children and families and further other charitable work. To that end, the corporation may adopt and establish By Laws, and make all rules and regulations deemed necessary and expedient for the management of its affairs, in accordance with law and not inconsistent with these articles of incorporation; and, to take and manage, hold and dispose of the property, real and personal of the corporation.

B) Community Outreach Efforts

To provide and facilitate services and activities for children and families that improve their welfare and strengthen community growth and stability in a faith-filled service environment. In connection with its purposes, this corporation may provide any and all kinds of services necessary or desirable to further the purposes of the corporation, and it may transact any and all business, engage in any and all activities and do any and all things which are lawful for a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

C) Publications and Donations

To publish and disseminate faith-based newspapers, books, tracts and the like, and to obtain funds by gifts, donations, grants, collect bequests and otherwise for the purposes of this corporation.

D) Education

To establish and maintain a school, institute or college for the instruction in and promotion of principles and studies for the intellectual, moral, spiritual and physical development and improvement of children and families; and for the promotion of health, harmony and happiness of children and families, and to apply such principles, counsels and teachings for such purposes; to furnish food and other aids and necessities recommended by this corporation; to use all lawful and usual methods and means of educating and aiding its students and to provide such instruction and counsel as might be required, to grant diplomas and confer degrees on its students who are deemed proficient and fitted to receive them.

E) Program Development

For the accomplishments of the objectives and purposes of this corporation, it has power to establish programs; to establish a library or libraries; to print, publish, bind and distribute such books, magazines, papers and other literature as will further carry out the objectives of this corporation; to lease suitable buildings and equipment, and to acquire by purchase of gifts such personal and real property as may be necessary to carry out the objectives of this corporation, and to receive subscriptions and donations of real and personal property to be applied to the uses and purposes of this corporation, and to execute such trusts; to mortgage or otherwise encumber any of its property, or to sell and convey the same; to permit the use of any of its property, for religious, educational, benevolent, or other lawful purposes. The corporation shall have the power to organize, conduct and supervise programs throughout Florida and shall be subject to and under the control of this corporation.

F) Family Empowerment and Spiritual Enhancement

To provide and maintain a place of help that benefits the poor and needy by ministering to their needs and necessities; by assisting them to establish themselves by bringing their minds and hearts under the influence of education and the Christian doctrines; by aiding the erring, the sick, the aged, the young, the homeless, the addicted by promoting their welfare according to the rules, regulations, doctrines, disciplines and usages of the Christian Faith; and, to carry on every kind of work necessary and incidental to the maintenance of such religious, educational, charitable and philanthropic work; and that all such work shall be conducted by this corporation not for pecuniary profit.

G) Real Estate Acquisition

The corporation is empowered and authorized to purchase, rent or acquire by all lawful means such real estate or the erection of such building(s), or personal properties as are necessary for the objectives and purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The management of this corporation shall be vested in a board of directors of not less than three directors as provided in the By Laws, which shall organize committees, departments and programs, and shall have supervision of all work of the corporation and shall make all contracts and leases, and have all such other powers as are conferred by law and the By Laws.

The method of election, term of office of directors, guidelines regarding removal of an officer, and how to fill vacancies shall be as stated in the By-Laws of this corporation.
