Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida Not For Profit Corporation adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

Article III shall be amended as follows:

J.D. HALL FOUNDATION, INC. is a Nonprofit Corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax-exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Specifically, this Nonprofit Corporation is organized and operated to provide relief to poor, distressed, and underprivileged students in dire need of financial assistance, and give them the invaluable opportunity to successfully obtain undergraduate degrees in colleges and universities throughout the country and become active members and leaders within our society.

Article IX shall be added, and shall include the following provisions:

Purpose of Obtaining 501(c)(3) Tax-Exempt Status: No part of the net earning of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth above. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Code.

Dissolution: Upon the dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
