ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF IGLESIA "EL NUEVO CAMINO" INC.

ARTICLE I (Name)

This congregation shall be known as Iglesia "El Nuevo Camino" Inc. of Lehigh Acres, Florida

ARTICLE II (Address)

The principal address is 1315 Homestead Rd. Unit H Lehigh Acres, Fl 33970 and the mailing address is P.O. Box 334 Lehigh Acres, Fl 33970.

ARTICLE III (Purpose)

The purpose of the Church is to reach people with the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and bring them to faith in Him, teaching and equipping believers through discipleship. To establish and maintain churches, parsonages, schools, chapels, radio, television and internet ministries, print shops, day care centers, camps and any other ministry that the church may be led of God to establish. To buy, handle, sell mortgage and lease real property for the growth and expansion of the church ministry.

ARTICLE IV (Declaration of Faith)

We Believe:

- 1. In the verbal inspiration of the Bible
- 2. In one God existing in three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 3. That Jesus is the only begotten son of the Father. Conceived by the Holy Spirit, born to a virgin (Mary). That Jesus was crucified, buried a rose from the dead on the third day.
- 4. That all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God and that repentance is commanded of God.
- 5. That justification, regeneration and the new birth are wrought by faith in the blood of Jesus Christ
- 6. In sanctification through the Word and the Holy Spirit.
- 7. Holiness to be God's standard of living for His people.
- 8. In water baptism by immersion, in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit
- 9. In the baptism with the Holy Spirit.
- 10. In the speaking with other tongues as the Spirit give utterance and that it is the initial evidence of the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- 11. Divine healing for all believers.
- 12. In the Lord's Supper and washing of the saints' feet.
- 13. In the pre-millennial second coming of Jesus. First, to resurrect the righteous dead and to catch away the living saints to Him in the air. Second, to reign on earth a thousand years.
- 14. In the bodily resurrection; eternal life for the righteous and eternal punishment for the wicked.

ARTICLE V (Membership)

Section 1. All who have accepted Jesus Christ as savior and Lord, who have been baptized as believers by immersion, who regularly associate themselves with the fellowship and who are willing to submit to the oversight of the Pastor and Elders of this body and have consented to sign and adhere to the membership covenant. (Per Article VI)

Section 2. Membership may be revoked by an action of the Pastor and Elders in accord with the principles set forth in the following scriptures: Mt. 18:15-18; 1Cor. 5:9-13; Rms 16:17

Section 3. Members may be received from other churches of like faith and order into the fellowship of this body by letters of dismiss ion and recommendation from the said churches unless in consequence of peculiar circumstances are unable to obtain said letter. Section 4. A letter of dismiss ion shall be granted for a member in full fellowship and good standing to a church of like faith and order with which the member wishes to unite. When such letter is granted, membership in this Church shall cease.

Section 4. There are two classifications of members: voting members and non-voting members. Voting members are all those who regularly associate themselves with the fellowship and adhere to the Membership Covenant, contributing with their tithes and offerings on a regular basis. Non-voting members are all those who have signed the membership covenant, but only attend and contribute financially on a sporadic basis to the church.

ARTICLE VI (Membership Covenant)

4. Collaborate with the ministry of my church

- A. Assisting to services and activities of my church Heb. 10:25
- B. Living a Godly life Phil. 1:27
- C. Contributing to the finances of the church 1 Cor. 16:2,3; Lev. 27:30

ARTICLE VII (Officers)

Section 1. The officers of this Church, all of whom shall be members in full fellowship and good standing will also be the corporate officers, who are to manage the legal and internal affairs of the church, shall be elected by the Pastor annually, and shall be as follows: President, Vice President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary (as needed) and Treasurer with one of more assistant.

President – Edwin Cintron Secretary – Raquel Cintron Treasurer – Gustavo Carpio

Section 2. The Pastor(s) shall receive such compensation for his (their) services as the church board may determine and that would be in keeping with regular and customary compensation giving consideration to regular Pastoral compensation.

Pastor Edwin Cintron Pastor Raquel Cintron

Section 3. The Elders aka. the Pastors Counsel shall consist of at least but no more than five members and shall be elected by the Pastor annually.

ARTICLE VIII (Duties of Officers)

Section 1. The Pastor(s):

- a. His (their) duties are four-fold: as Preacher, to proclaim the whole Gospel: as Bishop and President, to superintend the work of the church; as Pastor, to be shepherd of the flock; and as Minister to serve the people for Jesus' sake.
- b. The Pastor(s) shall be the presiding officer over elders meetings and other business meetings including general oversight over all departments of the church and serve as an ex-officio member of all committees.
- c. The Pastor(s) shall have sole and exclusive authority in the matter of hiring and dismissing staff members of the church.
- d. The oversight of all/any other paper work or additional records shall be the responsibility of the Pastor.

Section 2. The Elders aka the Pastors Counsel:

- a. The oversight of the congregation shall rest in a group of at least five elders which shall include the Pastor. Each of these individuals shall be a member of the fellowship.
- b. An elder maybe removed in accordance with the principles found in the following scriptures (Eph. 4:11-13, 1 Peter 5:1-3, 1 Tim. 3:1-7) If such a matter comes to trail, voting members of the congregation shall serve as jury.
- c. Meetings of the elders shall be called by giving at least twenty-four hours notice thereof personally or by mail to all the elders and such notice may be given by one of the elders; but by unanimous consent of the elders a meeting may be held without previous

notice thereof. the majority of the whole number of elders shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at an meeting lawfully convened.

- d. The elders shall have no power to call, settle, or remove the pastor, or to fix his salary, or without the consent of a corporate meeting, to incur debts beyond what is necessary for the administration of the temporal affairs of the church and for the care of the property of the corporation.
- e. Elders shall appoint deacons as needed with the approval of the Pastor.

Section 2. President:

a. The president shall serve as the chief executive officer and preside at all meetings of the corporation, execute all legal papers by order of the church and perform such other duties as may be provided by the charter or By-Laws as amended.

Section 3. Vice-President:

a. The vice-president shall act in the absence of the president and execute all legal papers by order of the church and perform such other duties as may be provided by the Charter or By-laws as amended.

Section 4. Secretary:

- a. The secretary shall keep a true and legal record of the minutes of the meetings of the corporation, attest and affix the corporate seal to all legal papers of the Church.
- b. To keep a record of the proceedings of all Church business meetings.
- c. To keep a register of the names of the members of the church; to sign all letters of dismiss ion.
- d. All church records and papers will be housed at current physical address of the Church The oversight of all/any other paper work or additional records shall be the responsibility of the Pastor.

Section 5. Assistant Secretary:

a. The assistant secretary shall act in the absence of the Secretary.

Section 6. Treasurer:

- a. The treasurer shall receive and disburse all monies in accordance with the approval of the Pastor.
- b. To render to the Pastor a monthly report of the financial operations for the proceeding month and the financial condition of the church at the close of said month.
- c. At the annual financial meeting he shall prepare a financial report to present to the church body.
- d. All church records and papers will be housed at current physical address of the Church The oversight of all/any other paper work or additional records shall be the responsibility of the Pastor.

Section 7. Assistant Treasurer

a. The assistant treasurer shall act in the absence of the Treasurer.

ARTICLE IX (Annual Meetings)

Section 1. The annual corporate meeting shall be held within 60 days of our fiscal year (September) at a time designated by the Pastor and Elders.

Section 2. The elders or pastor shall give notice of the time and place of its annual corporate meeting. The afore mentioned notice shall be publicly read by the pastor or any elder at a regular meeting of the church for public worship on the two successive Sundays immediately preceding such meeting.

ARTICLE X (Dissolution of Corporation)

Upon dissolution of this corporation, all assets of the Corporation shall be divided evenly among Iglesia El Nuevo Camino Fellowship, Florida. according to 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE XI (Ordination)

Section 1. Ordination procedure shall be conducted as follows:

Upon conference with Pastor and approval the candidate(s) for ordination, the Pastor shall call, examine and pass on the qualifications of the candidate

If the candidate(s) are approved for ordination by the pastor set a time for such ordination will be scheduled.

ARTICLE XII (Amendments)

The By-Laws of the church shall be made, altered, amended or rescinded only by a majority vote of the officers of the church with the pastoral approval.
