ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EVERY CHILD A READER ESCAMBIA, INC. A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT

The undersigned individual, desiring to form a corporation not for profit under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby subscribes to the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The name of the corporation is Every Child a Reader Escambia, Inc., and the principal office and mailing address of the corporation is 1708 North 14th Avenue, Pensacola, Florida 32503.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES

The corporation is organized and shall be operated for the following purposes:

- (a) To have all children entering kindergarten in the Escambia County School District in 2011 ready for kindergarten as measured by then current State standards, for all 3rd Graders in the Escambia County School District to test as proficient on the reading portion of the FCAT by 2014 as measured by then current State standards, and to create a literate workforce that contributes to economic growth and development in Escambia County.
- (b) The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- (c) Subject to paragraph (b) above, to exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations. Such powers include, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the power to acquire by bequest, gift, purchase, leave or otherwise any property of any sort or nature without limitation as its amount or value, and to hold, invest, reinvest, manage, use, apply, employ, sell, expend,

disburse, lease, mortgage, convey, option, donate or otherwise dispose of such property and the income, principal and proceeds of such property, for any of the purposes set forth herein.

(d) Subject to paragraph (b) above, to do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

This corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE IV - COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE AND TERM OF EXISTENCE

The date for commencement of this corporation's existence shall be the date these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Florida Secretary of State.

ARTICLE V - INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation are as follows:

ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The corporation shall have a Board of Directors who shall be known as the Vision Board of Directors (hereinafter the "Vision Board"). The Vision Board shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Vision Board with the method of election as stated in the bylaws of the corporation. The Vision Board shall have no more than fifty-five (55) members initially. The number of members of the Vision Board may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the bylaws of the corporation but shall never be less than three (3). The names and addresses of the members of the Initial Vision Board are as reflected in Exhibit A attached hereto.

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by an Executive Committee appointed by the Vision Board. The Executive Committee members shall be members of the

Vision Board and shall have no less than three (3) members nor more than nine (9) members. The Executive Committee shall have full power and authority to control the affairs of the corporation except for those matters requiring approval of the Vision Board as specifically provided in the Bylaws of the corporation. The Executive Committee shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Vision Board with the method of election as stated in the Bylaws of the corporation. ARTICLE VII - OFFICERS

The corporation shall have officers consisting of a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, and Treasurer, and such other officers as the Vision Board of the corporation shall in its discretion determine necessary or appropriate for accomplishing the objectives of the corporation. Officers of the Corporation shall be members of the Vision Board. The officers shall be elected by the Vision Board at the annual meeting of the Vision Board.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENT

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment to them and all rights and privileges conferred upon the Vision Board, Executive Committee and officers of the corporation are subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE IX - BYLAWS

The Bylaws of the corporation are to be made, altered, amended, or repealed by a majority vote of the Vision Board at a regular or special meeting of the Vision Board.

ARTICLE X - DISTRIBUTION ON DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed, in the manner determined by the Vision Board of the corporation, solely to charitable, religious, scientific, literary, or educational organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.

No Vision Board member, Executive Committee Member or officer of the corporation, nor any private individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

ARTICLE XI - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the registered office of this corporation shall be 1708 North 14th Avenue, Pensacola, Florida 32503, and the name of the registered agent of this corporation at that address shall be John Parnham.
