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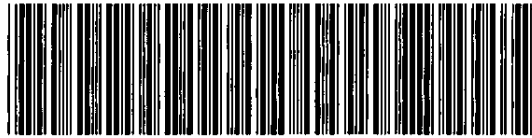

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

CORNERSTONE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF OVIEDO, INC.



The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Nonprofit Corporation under the Nonprofit Corporation Laws of Florida, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

CORPORATION NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be CORNERSTONE Missionary Baptist Church of Oviedo, Inc.

## **ARTICLE II**

### **DURATION**

The period of duration of this Corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to law. Corporate existence shall commence upon the filing of these Article of Incorporation.

## **ARTICLE III**

### **CORPORATE PURPOSES: POWERS**

1. The purpose for which the Corporation is organized and operated purpose is exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code tax code.

Such purposes shall include the following:

(a) Religious

(b) To conduct a local Church by the direction of our Lord Jesus Christ and under the leadership of the Holy Spirit in accordance with all the Commandments and provisions as set forth in the Holy Bible, the irrevocable Word of GOD. Pursuant thereto, the following activities and guidelines shall be established.

- i. A recognized creed, code of doctrine, discipline and form of worship shall be established.
- ii. Local Church government of autonomous rule shall be established
- iii. Ordination of ministers upon completion of prescribed training, courses of study and rigorous testing designated by this Church ministry.
- iv. An organization of ministers and ministries shall be established to minister to the needs of the local Church congregation and community.
- v. Establishment of Church membership based upon statement of confession of Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and desire to unite with local assembly.
- vi. Establishment of various religious services pursuant to our Church covenant, form of worship, and discipline of Church literature, and other forms of mass media for the purpose of educating the masses in the Word of GOD.

vii. Establishing Christian Education curriculum for the preparation of saints and ministers to minister the word of GOD.

- (c) Promote and encourage, through the ministry of the organization, cooperation with other organizations, ministering within the community.
- (d) To acquire and hold such property, either real or personal, for Church purposes, as may be necessary for it's membership and to Worship GOD.

2. As a means of accomplishing the above purposes and methods, The Corporation shall have the following powers:

- (a) To receive and accept gifts, donations of money and property and to hold the same for any of the purposes of the Corporation and it's work.
- (b) To raise and assist in raising funds for the purposes herein set forth, including the issuance of bonds or other instruments of credit.
- (c) To acquire own, lease, mortgage, and dispose of property both real and personal.
- (d) To conduct and carry on religious services and instruction through the public media, including electronic broadcasting, AM and FM radio, television, closed circuit transmission, cable television and internet broadcasting.
- (e) To accept property and donations in trust for religious and charitable purposes.
- (f) To acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock, bonds, obligation, or other securities of other corporations, domestic or foreign, as investment or otherwise, in carrying out any of the purposes of the Corporation an, while the owner thereof, to exercise all rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the power to vote thereon.

(3) The property of the Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious, educational, and charitable purpose, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, it's members, trustee, directors, offices or other private person, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(C)(3) purposes.

(a) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

(b) The Corporation shall not:

- i. Operate for the purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit;
- ii. Accumulate income, invest income, or divert income, in a manner endangering its exempt status; or
- iii. Except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activity or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of the Corporation.
- iv. The Corporation's operations are to be conducted principally in the United States of America.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

##### **REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT**

The initial street address and mailing address of the principal office and registered office of the Corporation is: 3583 Heirloom Rose Place Oviedo, Florida 32766, and the name of the registered agent at such address is Christian Frazier.

#### **ARTICLE V**

##### **MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS**

The powers of the Corporation shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the directions of, a Board of Directors which shall have three (3) directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by a majority of the directors, but at no time shall there be fewer than three (3) directors of the Corporation.

## **ARTICLE VI**

### **INITIAL DIRECTORS**

The manner in which the Directors of the Corporation shall be elected or appointed shall be governed by the provisions of the By-Laws of the Corporation. The names and street addresses of the initial directors of the Corporation are:

## **ARTICLE VIII**

### **MEMBERS**

This Corporation shall have members and they shall be admitted and qualified in accordance with the By-Laws adopted by the Board of Directors.

## **ARTICLE IX**

### **AMENDMENTS**

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by a majority of the directors in the manner set forth in the By-Laws of this Corporation.

**ARTICLE XI**  
**MISCELLANEOUS**

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities nor permitted to be carried on:

- i. By a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the IRC(or corresponding section of the any future Federal tax code)or
- ii. By a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of the IRC(or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

(b) Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

(c) The extent of personal liability, if any, for directors, officers, or members for corporate obligations and the methods of enforcement and collection, are as follows; NONE. Further, the Directors and offices shall be exempt from liability and/or indemnified from costs and judgments to the full extent permitted by Florida law. In the event that Florida law is subsequently amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of Directors or Officers or nonprofit corporations, then the liability of Directors and Officers of the corporation in addition to the limitation on personal liability provided under this Article, shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by such later amended Florida law.



This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these articles of incorporation, or any amendment hereto.
