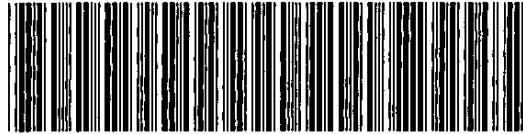

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is:

- .To help Clients develop job skills and experience in securing employment and achieve success in the workforce. To facilitate career counseling/development, job coaching, career transition, job referral through the use of applied technology; and**
- . To offer specialized services in vocational assessments and evaluation, skills assessments, basic skills development in employability skills and computer literacy , career planning, job counseling, and job placement; and**
- . To offer workshops to meet special needs of women, disable clients, minorities, immigrants, juveniles, ex-offenders, displaced workers, transition, new entrants and re-entrants into the job market; and**
