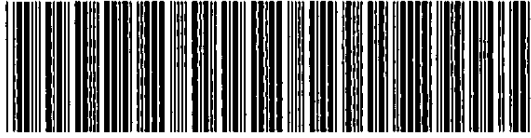

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this **Florida Not For Profit Corporation** adopts the following amendment(s) to its Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE Amended as: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, 1- the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, 2- the providing of free immigration services and other related assistance to foreign citizens immigrating to the United States of America with little or no financial possibilities while charging them a membership fee or a nominal fee depending on their ability to pay in order to defray some mandatory expenses without any prejudice if for any reason they cannot afford it (Exception made of any filing fee requested by the US Citizenship and Immigration Services Agency commonly denominated "BCIS" or USCIS and that would not be able to be waived for any reason and that will need to be paid to this agency directly using money order or cashier's checks or any other payment method requested by this US agency. 3- Giving legal alternatives in dealing with the US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS or BCIS) entities when not able to afford a licensed lawyer for their case, and even assisting them before the US Immigration Agency in the limits permitted by law or the legal US immigration authorities and appellate court or agencies etc.....

4- Assisting them in locating some probono lawyers willing to take their cases in such a need

5- Helping them to settle in the United States mostly in their home state, to get use to their new life, and also helping them seeking and finding assistance with English Languages translation and Interpretation, English language Training, Job trainings, medical assistance, legal assistance , School opportunities, Hiring application and job, Interview etc....), to educate them about any immigration or social or educational benefit they are entitle to, due to their immigration status

6-Exercising all the powers conferred upon corporations formed under the Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act in order to accomplish the corporation's educational, Charitable, religious and scientific purposes; and to take other actions necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized.

THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES HAVE BEEN ADDED:

ARTICLE VIII: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial trustees of the corporation are as follows: Name: Clifford Knaggs

ARTICLE IX: The corporation shall not issue corporate stocks

ARTICLE X: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying

on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

If reference to federal law in articles of incorporation imposes a limitation that is invalid in your state, you may wish to substitute the following for the last sentence of the preceding paragraph:

"Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

ARTICLE XI: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


