ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In compliance with Chapter 617 F.S. (Not for Profit)

Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be:

Seminole YouthBuild, Inc.

Article II Principal Office and Mailing Address

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be:

Article III Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Exclusively for charitable, professional, educational and civic purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to provide and to promote the educational and general social welfare of the youth in Central Florida, and for that purpose:

- a. to acquire, improve and operate any real or personal property or interest or rights therein or appurtenant thereto;
- b. to provide the youth of the area a safe place to learn, without regard to age, sex, color, creed, religion, or national origin;
- c. to improve the quality of life for all residents in the area by reducing crime in the area, educating youth in a vocational trade and general high school curriculum;
- d. to create a college fund and scholarships for youth education;
- e. to financially assist youth who want to attend the Youthbuild program in order to become employed without regard to age, sex, color, creed, religion, or national origin;
- f. to support educational and recreational programs for youth without regard to age, sex, color, creed, religion, or national origin

- g. to assist children and needy families and children in the community
- h. to assist, promote, support and enhance programs that address youth health and safety concerns and attendant needs;
- i. to lease facilities in which the youth advance their academic and vocational training objectives;
- j. to help youth to engage in and complete their matriculation toward gaining their high school diploma;
- k. to employ teaching assistance to design, coordinate and implement an education program directed toward fulfilling all education requirements for youth to gain their high school education and a diploma upon graduation;
- l. to assist youth to engage and complete vocational training (i.e. carpentry, landscaping, drywall, roofing, OSHA safety regulations, auto mechanics, auto body repair, nursing, and other vocational endeavors);
- m. to employ an educator or educational organization to design, coordinate and implement an vocational program directed toward fulfilling all education requirements for youth to gain certification in specific area upon graduation;
- n. to provide youth with supplies needed for high school education to including books, textbooks, computers, computer programs etc.;
- o. to provide at risk youth with supplies needed for vocational training to including tools, safety protective gear, training materials, uniforms, books, textbooks, computer programs etc.;
- p. to employ a career counselor to design, coordinate and implement a job development curriculum directed toward assisting with resume development, job searching skills, employment interviews and job placement.
- q. to employ a director to design, coordinate and implement program and to and oversee the daily operations
- r. to transact any and all lawful business which nonprofit corporations may conduct pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida
