

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, education and scientific purposes, including for such purposes as making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)

It will function solely in the area of religious activities. It will engage in the exclusive activity of spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ and promoting Christian growth from a Biblical standpoint. It will act in an evangelistic manner to support the local church as well as other various religious activities including youth work, seminars, etc. It will be funded solely by three basic sources:

- 1. Honorariums for services rendered at various religious activities.
- 2. Love offerings from same religious sources.
- 3. Regular giving from donors who will help support the ministry on a monthly basis.

All funds received will be put into a corporate account and distributed according to federal and state laws as well as the laws of the corporation. The main thrust of this ministry will be to minister in the local church. The ministry of the church will be to:

- 1. Minister to the spiritual needs of the people as far as seeing revival take place.
- 2. Conduct evangelistic work in the community through meetings, radio and television, and printed materials.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

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Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
