# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

# FUNDACIÓN VOY A CAMBIAR EL MUNDO, INC.

The Undersigned, acting as incorporator of a Not for Profit Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be FUNDACIÓN VOY A CAMBIAR EL MUNDO, INC.

#### **ARTICLE II - DURATION**

This corporation shall have perpetual existence. The corporation's existence shall commence on the date of execution of these articles.

#### ARTICLE III - GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSE

The purpose for which the Corporation is formed, and the business and the objects to be carried on and promoted by it, are as follows:

- A. The Corporation is incorporated as a nonprofit corporation, organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporation Not for Profit Law set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes and within the scope of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, including Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they my hereafter be amended.
- B. To operate exclusively in any other manner for such religious, charitable, and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax Laws.
- C. The specific purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to promote and preserve traditional Christian and religious values through education and services.
- D. In furtherance of these purposes the Corporation may exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- E. Said corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

F. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

#### ARTICLE IV - STOCK

The Corporation is to be organized on a non-stock basis.

#### **ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP**

The qualifications for members, and the manner of their admissions, rights, duties, and obligations, if any, shall be regulated by the Bylaws for this Corporation.

#### ARTICLE VI - INITIAL OFFICE

#### ARTICLE VII - MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

A. Board of Directors: The Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors which shall consist of such numbers of directors as may be fixed from time to time by the board of the Corporation as provided for in the Bylaws, but in no event shall the Board of Directors of the Corporation consist of fewer than three (3) directors.

- C. Officers: The Officers of the Corporation shall be appointed and selected as my be prescribed in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these articles of incorporation or any amendment hereto.
