(A Florida Corporation Not-For-Profit)

These articles constitute the Articles of Incorporation of the CENTRAL FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF PHYSICIANS FROM THE INDIAN SUBCONTINENT INC., a corporation not-to-profit organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

Article I Name

The name of the Corporation is CENTRAL FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF PHYSICIANS FROM THE INDIAN SUBCONTINENT, INC.

Article II Not Profit Purpose

The Corporation is organized exclusively for scientific, educational, cultural and charitable purposes. The Corporation's specific purposes are:

- 1. To serve as a forum to facilitate and enable Indian American physicians, dentists and other medical scientists to excel in patient care, teaching and research, and to pursue their aspiration in professional and community affairs.
- 2. To bring together physicians, dentists and other medical scientists of Indian / Indo-American heritage residing in Central Florida.
- 3. To assist medical, dental and students of human sciences and physicians & dentists in pursuing their career.
- 4. To conduct seminars and other educational programs to acquaint members of new scientific developments in the field of human medicine.

- 5. To support and foster the availability of medical assistance to indigent people in Central Florida and India.
- 6. To make contributions to organizations that qualify as tax exempt organizations under section 50l(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now and hereafter amended (the "Code").
- 7. To provide mutual understanding and cooperation between this association and other medical societies.
- 8. To maintain a directory of physicians of Indian / Indo-American origin.
- 9. To provide other member services as needed.
- 10. Generally to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida, or which may hereafter be conferred, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property; provided, however, that this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation.
- 11. This corporation is organized as a trade associations within the scope and meaning of associations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of the any future United State Internal Revenue). Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by associations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (6) of the Code and the regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporations shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purpose as set forth in and limited by these Articles.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to associations that qualify as exempt organization under Section 501 (c) of the Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of the such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by of the appropriate Court of the county in which principle office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article III Duration

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual.

Article IV Membership

Membership in the Corporation shall be as regulated by the bylaws.

Articles V Principal Office and Mailing Address

The principal office address and mailing address of the corporation is 3241 Yattika Place, Longwood, Florida 32779.

Article VI Initial Registered Office and Registered Agent
