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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO AMEND ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION MAMA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, INC.

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Pursuant to the provision of chapter 617, Florida Statutes the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of incorporation filed on December 10, 2007.

FIRST:

The following article is amended and should read as follows:

Article II- Purpose

The corporation is organized exclusively for the purpose of providing scholarships for needy children pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 212.08(7) and within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future Federal tax code.

SECOND:

The following articles are added and should read as follows:

Article III -Permitted Activities

Notwithstanding, any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax, under Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Article IV - Shares

This corporation is organized under a non-stock basis.

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Articles XIII - Dedication of Asseta

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and cultural purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

Articles XIV - Distribution of Earnings

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public offices
