ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

1. As per S501(C)(3) the specific and primary purposes for which this Corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of education and research and for other charitable purposes, and particularly for cooperative endeavors among the people of Central Florida. The Corporation will serve as a source of information through the education of its members and the public in general, from online sources and books.
2. ARTICLE IV ACTIVITIES

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or to be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or any other private individual, or persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three. No part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in

opposition to any candidate for public office. The Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Inland Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any provision of this document, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on;

1. By a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Inland Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code or
2. By a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Inland Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE V DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Inland Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. 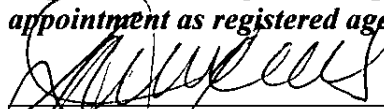
