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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

BROWARD ATTORNEYS' REAL ESTATE COUNCIL, INC.



The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a not-for-profit Corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following as the Articles of Incorporation of Broward Attorneys' Real Estate Council, Inc.

ARTICLE I

NAME, ADDRESS, DURATION, REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

- (a) The name of the corporation is Broward Attorneys' Real Estate Council, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".
- (b) The address of the principal office and mailing address of the Corporation is 2850 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311-2514.
 - (c) The existence of the Corporation will be perpetual.
