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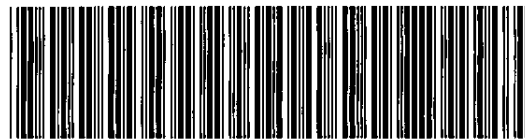

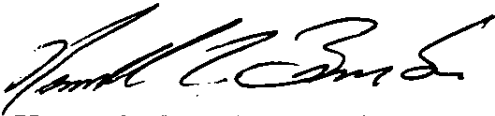

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
The Sanctuary Of Ocala, Inc.**

(A Non - Profit Corporation)

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, are natural persons residing in Florida, competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I : NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the corporation shall be : THE SANCTUARY OF OCALA, INC. and its principle place of business address shall be: 5510 NE 4th Ave., Ocala, Florida 34479.

ARTICLE II : PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, religious and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ, to spread HIS salvation message, to encourage and assist Christian believers in attaining a deeper spiritual maturity through the power of the Holy Spirit, and to own , operate and maintain a ministry and church for that purpose. The corporation shall have no power of authority to accomplish any transaction described as a prohibited transaction in Section 503 of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, nor shall it engage in any activity which shall in any way forfeit the corporation's status as exempt from taxation under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or the federal, state or local government for exclusive public service.

ARTICLE III : MEMBERSHIP

The membership of this corporation shall be comprised of all persons names herein as subscribers, directors and officers to these Articles of Incorporations, and membership in the corporation shall at all times be open to other persons who shall be interested in the furtherance of the purposes of the corporation. The conditions and regulations of membership and the rights and other privileges of the classes of membership shall be determined and fixed by the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV : TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI : BY-LAWS

By-Laws of the corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded upon a two-thirds vote of the membership present at any regular business meeting, or at any special meeting called for that purpose, after due written notice to all members of the church. The by-laws of the church set forth the method for electing officers of the church. This method is subject to change based on a two-thirds vote of the membership as noted above.

ARTICLE VII: AMENDMENTS

These Article of Incorporation may be altered, changed, or amended by two-thirds vote of the membership of the church present at any regular business meeting called for that purpose, provided that proper notice has been given and that such proposed alterations, changes, or amendments have been submitted in writing to the membership for their consideration at a regular meeting prior to their adoption. When approved by a two-thirds vote of the membership present at such meeting, the said changes, alterations or amendments to the Articles of Incorporation must also be forwarded to the Secretary of State and filed and approved by that office before same shall become effective.

ARTICLE VIII: NON-STOCK CORPORATION

The corporation shall be non-stock and no dividends net earnings, or pecuniary profits shall be declared, distributed to or inured to the benefit of any member, director or officer of this corporation.
