ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

for

A Nonprofit Corporation in compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (Not For Profit).

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ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation shall be: The 2nd Florida Volunteers Living History, Inc.

ARTICLE 2

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 7934 South Park Place, Orlando, FL 32819.

ARTICLE 3

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

To further the public's awareness and understanding of the history of the 2nd Florida Volunteer Infantry Regiment during the War Between The States, as well as military and civilian life during the years 1860 through 1865. The means of providing such awareness and understanding includes, but is not limited to, lectures, seminars, round-table discussions, living history encampments, and reenactments of historical events.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 4

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

The directors of this corporation shall be elected my majority vote of the corporation's membership. Each Director shall hold office for a period of three (3) years and until his or her successor is elected and qualifies. One-third of the Directors shall be elected each year. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
