ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION GREEN LIVING COUNCIL OF SOUTHWEST FLORIDA, INC.

<u>ARTICLE III. PURPOSE</u> The corporation is incorporated for the following purpose or purposes:

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the preceding paragraph. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, (the "Code"), as amended, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code, as amended.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, none of its assets shall inure to the benefit of any member or individual person. After paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, all of the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, as amended, as the Board of Directors shall determine.

Additional purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

- a. To develop and adopt green and living standards for the State of Florida;
- b. To develop and implement a certification program for energy efficient and sustainable green building and living standards;
- c. To educate the general public, businesses, institutional and governmental bodies of the long term benefits of sustainable green living and building standards;
 - d. To promote and educate the public about green living practices;
- e. To improve the energy efficiency, energy conservation potential, indoor air quality, water conservation potential and sustainability of buildings;



- f. To encourage housing affordability by increasing building sustainability;
- g. To stimulate statewide acquaintance and fellowship among members and others interested in green living practices;
- h. To provide opportunities for members and other interested parties to increase their knowledge of green living practices.
