## Articles Of Incorporation

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## Of HIGHLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CARRY OF STATE OR OR ATION, INC.

A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, natural person of the age of eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., do hereby set forth:

Article I The name of the corporation is Highland County Community Development Corporation, Inc.

- Article III The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
  - a. Highlands County Community Development Corporation, Inc. organized for exclusively religious, charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. Specifically, the organization will hold workshops and seminars to educate the public on various topics such as but not limited to life skills, resume building, job skills, financials or debt issues and home buyer education.
  - b. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.


