We, the undersigned, acknowledge and file in the Office of the Secretary of the State of Florida, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, these Articles of Incorporation, as by law provided.

ARTICLE I Name

1.1. The name of the Corporation shall be North Port Firefighters Benevolent Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation," and the principal office shall be 3415 Magic Oak Lane, Sarasota, Florida 34232.

ARTICLE II Purposes and Powers

2.1 Purposes. The purposes for which the Corporation is to further the welfare of members of the North Port Fire Department, their families and to promote their public relationship and good will with the North Port community.

ARTICLE III Membership

- 3.1 General Membership: General membership shall be limited to full time employees of the North Port Fire Rescue Department, retired employees and their adult family members.
