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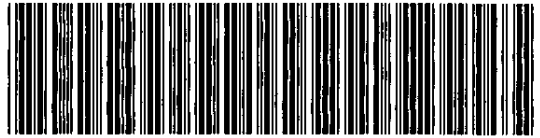



Purposes and Objectives of the Corporation

The purposes and objectives for which the corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") is organized are:

(a) To identify and analyze critical issues, trends, and developments in higher education and to seek constructive solutions to important problems.

(b) To provide organized focus and leadership for the varied interests, institutions, and efforts of higher education.

(c) To improve higher education, and to use higher education to advance the general welfare--nationally and internationally.

(d) To assist in coordinating the efforts of educational institutions and agencies at all levels.

(e) To provide for liaison and cooperation of higher education with state and national governmental agencies and with foundations.

(f) To encourage the improvement of the qualities and competencies of professional people in all areas of higher education, and to improve the conditions for effective performance.

(g) To promote research, experimentation, and adaptive developments in colleges and universities.

(h) To assist in the collection, organization, and dissemination of valid and useful information on current issues in higher education.

(i) To develop a better understanding by the general public of higher education and of college teaching as a profession.

(j) To promote opportunities for sharing the benefits of college-level and advanced education by an increasing proportion of the population.

Provided that the Association shall not engage in any activity which would be inconsistent with the status of an educational and charitable organization as defined in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any successor provision thereto, and none of the said purposes shall at any time be deemed or construed to be purposes other than the public benefit purposes and objectives consistent with such educational and charitable status.
