### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

#### A FLORIDA NON PROFIT CORPORATION

# ARTICLE I Corporate Name

The name of this corporation shall be Greater Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church of Deerfield Beach Florida, Inc. Its principal address shall be 370 North Deerfield Avenue, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33441.

# ARTICLE II Corporate Nature

This is a nonprofit corporation, organized solely for general educational and charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit law set forth in Section 617 of the Florida Statutes.

### ARTICLE III Duration

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

# ARTICLE IV General and Specific Purpose

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- a) For the advancement of education and any other related or corresponding charitable purposes by the distribution of its funds for such purposes.
- b) To provide scholarships to students.
- To operate exclusively in any other manner for such educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, (or the corresponding provision of any other applicable Internal Revenue Law) as amended, or under any corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt.

· Organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, including private foundations and private operating foundations.

### ARTICLE V Management of Corporate Affairs

a) Board of Trustees. The power of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Trustees. The number of Trustees of the corporation shall be four (4), however, that number may be changed by a by law duly adopted by the members.

The Trustees named herein as the first Board of Trustees shall hold office until the first meeting of members at which time an election of Trustees shall be held.

Trustees elected at the first annual meeting, and at all times thereafter, shall serve for a term of one (1) year until the annual meeting of members following the election of Trustees and until the qualification of the successors in office. Annual meetings shall be held at 370 N. Deerfield Beach Ave., Deerfield Beach, Florida on 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of July at 1:00 pm or at such other times or places as the Board of Trustees may designate from time to time by resolution.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Trustees under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be files with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote of the Trustees. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the Board of Trustees without a meeting, and that the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of this corporation authorize the Trustees to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

b) Corporate Officers. The Board of Trustees shall elect the following officers: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer and such other officers as the bylaws of this corporation may authorize the Trustees to elect from time to time, initially, such officers shall be elected at the first annual meeting of the Board of Trustees.

### ARTICLE VI Earnings and Activities of Corporation

- a) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.
- b) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carryon any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt for Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to any insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

### ARTICLE VII Distribution of Assets

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation; dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational religious, or organization or organizations under section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such

Assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
