# Articles Of Incorporation

### LIGHT BEARER'S, INC.

### A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, natural person of the age of eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., do hereby set forth:

Article I The name of the corporation is **Light Bearer's**, **Inc.**.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

a. Light Bearer's, Inc. organized for exclusively religious, charitable, educational Article II

- and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. - b. - c. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- Article IV The board of directors of the corporation shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided in the Bylaws.
