

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I: Name

Greater Nassau Association for Traffic Safety Inc.

Article II: The principal place of business and mailing address:

67 Woodstork Lane, Fernandina Beach FL 32034 or at such place or places as the Board may designate.

Article III: The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized.

The Corporation is organized for all legal purposes under Florida law, and within the meaning of section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, as may be amended, including, but not limited to, the following:

1. To provide a formal resource for the citizens of Nassau County, Florida, to petition government agencies (local, state, federal), and the courts to express concerns over policies and decisions that adversely affect the quality of life and public safety in Nassau County.
2. To take action (including participation in meetings, forums, debates and actions at law) concerning the quality of life and public safety.
3. To review and respond to land use planning, zoning and permitting issues and applications;
4. To educate, evaluate, report on and distribute data on land use, public safety, conservation, wildlife, air, water and natural resources;
5. To use media resources to promote public awareness and education on land use, public safety, environmental issues and conservation;
6. To promote and secure the enforcement of laws and regulations for protection of the public, the quality of life, wildlife, air, water and natural resources;
7. To promote the enactment of laws that promote and advance the common interests of the members this organization.

Quality of Life shall include:

1. The necessary infrastructure to maintain the existing standards of living in Nassau County as assured by the State of Florida laws including, but not limited to, the State's Concurrency Law and the Nassau County Comprehensive Plan.
2. Control of traffic on state and county roads within Nassau County so they do not diminish traffic safety in accordance with Section 337.273 of Florida Statutes and the State and County Concurrency Laws.
3. Protection of the environment including trees, waterways, marshlands and wetlands, areas designated as "Conservation" in the Nassau County Comprehensive Plan, and by various State agencies.

Article IV: Board of Directors

The business affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors.

Five temporary directors are determined by volunteering for the purpose of forming this Association. Thereafter, at a time to be determined but not longer than one year from the date of incorporation, there shall be an election of directors by the membership; **the method of election of the directors will be stated in the bylaws.**

The directors shall elect from among their number a chairman, vice chairman and treasurer.

A vacancy on the Board of Directors shall be filled by the Board of Directors at a duly held meeting.

Members of the Association shall be those persons who have made at least a \$50 contribution to the Association.

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission shall be as stated in the by laws of the Corporation.

Article X - By-Laws

The Board shall adopt such by-laws for the conduct of its business and for carrying out its purpose and objectives as it may deem necessary.

The By-Laws shall provide the method by which they may be amended, altered or rescinded.

Article XI - Amendments

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended as provided for in the By-Laws.

Article XII - Non-Profit Status

No part of the funds of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any individual or member.

Article XIII - Indemnity

Every Director and every officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified and held harmless by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including attorney's fees, reasonably incurred by, or imposed upon, him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party, or in which he may become involved, by reason of his being or having been a director or officer at the time such expenses are or were incurred, except in such cases wherein the director or officer is adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance or fraud in the performance of his duties. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officer be entitled.


