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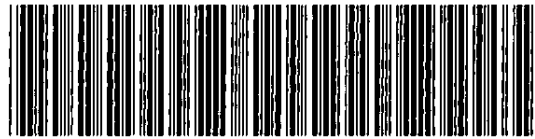

**Articles of Incorporation**  
**of**  
**Faith's Place of Community Arts and Education, Incorporated**

**Article I – Name**

The name of this corporation is Faith's Place of Community Arts and Education, Incorporated.

**Article II – Principal Office**

The principal office for the transaction of business of this corporation is to be located at 1549 W. 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Riviera Beach, FL 33404.

**II – Purposes and Powers**

- A. The specific purposes for which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable and educational:
  - 1. To provide a place where students can retreat after school to complete homework, learn FCAT strategies, and participate in cultural and artistic endeavors as a means to avoid and deter at risk behaviors and environments while making it affordable for low income parents;
  - 2. To provide educational opportunities and programs for motivated, but underserved youth;
  - 3. To provide quality educational opportunities for all students;
  - 4. To provide a safe and secure environment where said persons can enjoy learning; and
  - 5. To provide quality, research-based instructional programs for the benefit of said residents.
- B. The general purposes and powers are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on corporations formed under the laws of the State of Florida. In furtherance but not in limitation of the foregoing charitable and educational purposes, the Corporation shall have the following powers:
  - 1. To solicit, collect and receive money and other assets, and to administer funds and contributions received by grant, gift, deed, bequest or devise, and otherwise to acquire money, securities, property rights and services of every kind and description;
  - 2. To hold, bequest, expend, contribute, use, sell or otherwise dispose of any money, securities, property, rights or services so acquired for the purposes above mentioned;
  - 3. To develop highly educated, well rounded students who are excited about learning and to maintain a stable and dependable learning environment which addresses the goals and abilities of all students;
  - 4. To serve as a positive leadership force in the community and to engage in youth development programming and related activities in order to improve the lives of the above-mentioned residents;
  - 5. To engage in any and all other activities which will directly or indirectly improve the welfare and conditions of said residents and groups; and
  - 6. To exercise all other rights and powers conferred upon corporations formed under the General Nonprofit Law of the State of Florida, provided however, that the Corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the specific and primary charitable and educational purposes of this Corporation.
- C. All of the foregoing purposes and powers shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and educational purposes in such manner that the Corporation shall qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 ( c ) ( 3 ) of the Internal Revenue Code as it is currently and shall hereafter be in force and effect.
- D. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501( c ) ( 3 ) of the Internal Revenue Code or future federal tax code.


**Article VIII – Amendment**




