## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GABRIEL HEYMANS MINISTRIES, INC.

#### **ARTICLE 1**

NAME: The name of the corporation shall be: GABRIEL HEYMANS MINISTRIES, INC.

# **ARTICLE 11**

The name and address of the corporation is: GABRIEL HEYMANS MINISTRIES, INC., 2 Julip Lane, Flagler Beach, FL 32136. Mailing address: GABRIEL HEYMANS MINISTRIES, INC., P.O. Box 158, Bunnell, FL. 32110.

#### ARTICLE 111

PURPOSE: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all-lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may be incorporated under the law of the State of Florida, as they may be amended from time to time.

This nonprofit corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes as within the meaning of Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended of the United States of America.

- (a) To employ qualified counsel and other necessary personnel to carry out the purposes of this corporation.
- (b) To spread the gospel of Jesus Christ through preaching and teaching of the bible, traveling throughout the United States and all nations.
- (c) To receive tithes, offerings and property by gifts subject to the laws relating to the transfer of property by gift or will.
- (d) To borrow and to loan money and to give and to receive evidence if indebtedness and security; to draw, make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes, and other debentures of the corporation, or make guarantees of every kind and secure any or all obligations of the corporation by mortgage, trust deed or otherwise.
- (e) To receive, purchase or otherwise acquire to own, hold, occupy, use and enjoy, manage, improve, develop and work; to grant, sell, exchange, let demise and otherwise dispose of real estate, buildings and improvements and every right, interest and estate therein without limit as to amount thereof. To erect, construct, alter and repair buildings; to assume any and every kind of contract, agreement and obligation by or with any person, firm, corporation, etc.
- (f) To appoint officers and employees as may be decreed proper; define their authority and duties; fix their compensation; require bonds as it deems advisable; dismiss officers or employees for any good reason and appoint others to fill their places.
- (g) To minister sacerdotal functions.
- (h) To use any and all media in the furtherance of its not for profit tax exempt purposes.
- (i) To provide audio & visual teachings, books and any material for the spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- (j) To provide a Christian day care and school for children so that Christian morals and teachings will be available for those who choose a Christian environment and education for their children.
- (k) To provide an outreach, including facilities, to care for the homeless, unwed mothers, abused women and children and chemically dependent people.

### **ARTICLE IV**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose of set forth in Article III. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b)by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of the future United States Internal Revenue laws).

## **ARTICLE V**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all its assets exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations or organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific pur5pose as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue Laws) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by the Superior Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

## ARTICLE VI

The corporation will not practice or permit discrimination on the basis of sex, age, race, national origin, religion or physical handicap or disability.

#### ARTICLE VII

The Corporation will not have members.

#### **ARTICLE VIII**

The President and the Vice President of the corporation will appoint all directors.

#### **ARTICLE IX**
