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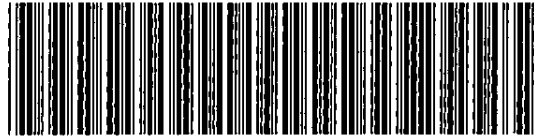

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
VOLUNTEERS ASSISTING VETERANS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is: **VOLUNTEERS ASSISTING VETERANS, INC.**

ARTICLE II.

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to law. Corporate existence shall commence upon filing with the Secretary of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE III.

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To provide services and assistance to all United States veterans, including but not limited to transportation back and forth from their home to veterans' hospitals and medical treatment; and financial assistance in emergency situations for veterans on their utility and food bills.

ARTICLE IV.

The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be provided for in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V.

The street address and the city of the corporation and its initial registered office is: 1925 Harden Blvd. #214, Lakeland, Florida 33803. The name of its initial registered agent is **JAMES F. JEFFREY**, whose address is 1925 Harden Blvd #214, Lakeland, Florida 33803.

ARTICLE VI.

The members of the corporation shall elect a Board of Directors from the membership. The method of election of directors shall be provided for in the By-laws of the corporation. The number of Directors shall be set forth in the By-Laws and may be increased from time to time by the By-Laws, but shall never be less than three (3) members. The initial Board of Directors, who shall serve until the first annual meeting of the corporation or as otherwise provided for in the By-Laws are:

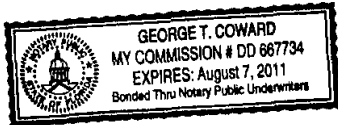
