**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MACEDONIA AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC.**

(Not for Profit)

The Undersigned, a Majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation law of the State of Florida, PURSANT to Florida Statutes, and do hear by adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation, Do hear by certify:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be:

Macedonia African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The Place in this State where the principal office of the corporation is to be located in the city of Fernandina Beach, Florida and the County of Nassau:

The Specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

This not for Profit Corporation shall indemnify any officer or Director, adviser to the full extent permitted by law and reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these articles or amendments here to.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows:

The powers and responsibilities of the corporation are limited by the rules and regulations of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. and the current edition of "The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church".

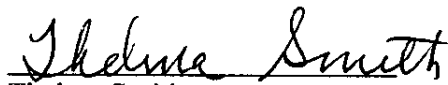
