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## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### **OF**

### CHARLOTTE FOUNDATION FOR THE PREVENTION OF HUNGER & HOMELESSNESS, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Not for Profit corporation in compliance with Chapter 617, of the Florida Statutes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be: Charlotte Foundation for the Prevention of Hunger & Homelessness, Inc.

SECOND: The address of the principal office of the Corporation shall be 225 W. Virginia Avenue, Punta Gorda, FL 33950.

THIRD: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The primary purpose of this corporation is to source funds to support the prevention of homelessness and hunger in Charlotte County, Florida.

FOURTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

FIFTH: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the

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principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SIXTH: The affairs of the corporation are to be managed by a Board of Trustees comprised of not less than three individual members of the corporation and they shall be elected at the annual meeting of the corporation, the number of trustees and the time and place of the election of trustees are to be fixed and established in the Bylaws of the corporation from time to time. The Board of Trustees annually shall elect from among the membership of said Board a President, one or more Vice Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer and such other officers as shall be established and provided for in the Bylaws.

SEVENTH: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial Board of Trustees of the corporation are as follows:

EIGHTH: The Board of Trustees shall have the power to make, adopt, alter, amend, and rescind the Bylaws of the corporation.

NINTH: The Board of Trustees of this corporation have the power to adopt amendments to these Articles of Incorporation by a majority vote of the trustees then in office subject, however, to the statutory requirement for approval by and filing with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

TENTH: The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual or until the corporation shall be dissolved in accordance with the provisions of law.
