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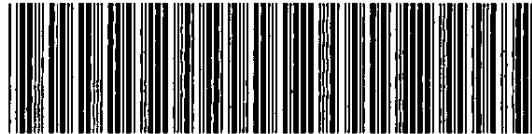

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**Articles of Incorporation
Of
Community Support for Youth and Families in Need, Inc.**

Article 1.

The name of the corporation is Community Support for Youth and Families in Need, Inc.

Article 2.

St. Augustine

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at 2425 Den Street, FL 32092 in St. Johns county. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be Ardain Isma.

Article 3.

The name and address of the incorporator is:

Article 4.

The Corporation shall not have Members.

Article 5.

The initial principal office and mailing address of the Corporation shall be at: 2425 Den Street, St. Augustine FL 32092.

Article 6.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational or religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), including, but not limited to the following:

Strengthening disenfranchised families in Florida.

Article 7.

The Corporation shall have perpetual duration.

Article 8.

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number of Directors of the Corporation and method of election shall be set out more specifically in the Bylaws. Initial Board Member is

Ardain Isma

Article 9.

The Corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the property or net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in hereinabove. The Corporation shall not carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempted to influence legislation to such extent as would result in loss of its exemption from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the code, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or the corresponding statute.

Article 10.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, religious or educational purposes and shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization described in Section 501(c) (3).

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, to another organization as said the court shall determine, to be used in such a manner as in the judgment of the court will best accomplish the general purposes for which the dissolved organization was organized.
