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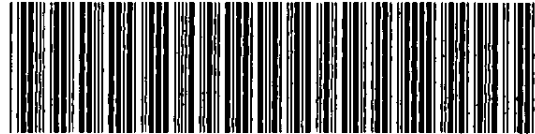

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TREADWAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTO, INC.

SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

TO: STATE CORPORATION COMMISSION:

The undersigned natural person of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporator, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation pursuant to the State Nonstock Corporations Act:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is: **TREADWAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTO, INC.**, 10619 Treadway School Road, Leesburg, Fl. 34788, Phone No. 352-742-2291.

SECOND: The Corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. (All references to sections in these Articles refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue laws.) Specifically, the corporation is organized to support the education of children at Treadway Elementary School by fostering relationships between the school, parents and teachers. In pursuance of these purposes it shall have the powers to carry on any business or other activity which may be lawfully conducted by a corporation organized under the Florida Nonstock Corporations Act, whether or not related to the foregoing purposes, and to do all things necessary, proper and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3).

THIRD: The officers of this organization shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, and a Treasurer. The officers shall be elected at the September meeting of the organization, by the members present at that meeting. Any PTO member is eligible to be a board member.

FOURTH: The Corporation may have one or more classes of members, the qualifications and rights, including voting rights, of which shall be designated in the bylaws.

FIFTH: The registered agent is Karen Sargent who is a resident of the state of Florida and a director of the corporation, and the address of its initial registered office is 10619 Treadway School Road, Leesburg, Florida, which is physically located in the county of Lake.

SIXTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is Four, and the names and addresses, including street number, of the Persons who are to serve as the initial directors until the first annual meeting, or until their successors are elected and qualified are:

SEVENTH: The internal affairs of the corporation shall be regulated by its Board of Directors as described in the Bylaws. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

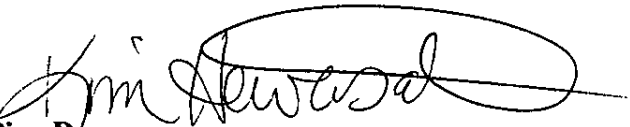
EIGHTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director, employee or other individual, partnership, estate, trust or corporation. Compensation for services actually rendered and reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending to the affairs of this corporation shall be limited to reasonable amounts. No substantial amount of the propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles or any of Bylaws adopted there under, this corporation shall not take any action not permitted by the laws which then apply to this corporation.

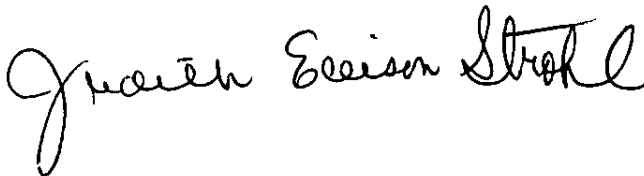
