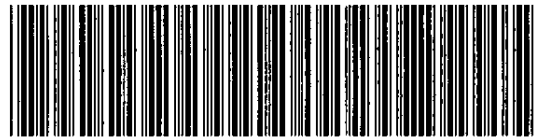

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**OF**

**BRUISED BUT NOT BROKEN, INC**

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SECRETARY OF STATE  
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Nonprofit Corporation under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of the said corporation shall be Bruised But Not Broken, Inc.

SECOND: The place in Florida where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is 13233 Sunkiss Loop, Windermere, FL 34786.

THIRD: The purpose for which said corporation is formed are:

- A) To receive and maintain real or personal property, or both and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (C)(3) of the IRC code and its regulations as they now exist or they may hereafter be amended. More specifically, these purposes shall include but are not limited to:
1. Implement, grow, and sustain a variety of programs that will reduce domestic violence abuse in women, assist the elderly, rehabilitate incarcerated men, combat juvenile delinquency, teach proper parenting skills, create financial stability, address sexual abuse and incest, eliminate poverty and homelessness, provide low-income housing assistance, encourage voter registration, and connect communities to achieve common goals.
  2. Connect and network interested agencies, programs, and grass root organizations to form collaborative partnerships that will work together to expand and enhance services to underserved people in their communities.
- B) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three hereof.
- C) Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or adequately providing for all the debts, obligations, and liabilities of the Corporation, distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation exclusively for the nonprofit charitable, religious, or educational purposes to such organization or organizations which are tax exempt under section 501 (C)(3) of the Code, as amended, as the Board of Directors in its sole discretion shall determine. The extent of personal liability, if any, for directors, officers, or members for corporate obligations and the methods of enforcement and collection, are as follows:

NONE. Further, the Directors and Officers shall be exempt from liability and/or indemnified from costs and judgments to the full extent permitted by Florida law. In the event the (Florida) law is subsequently amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of Directors or Officers of nonprofit corporations, then the liability of Directors and Officers of the corporation in addition to the limitation on personal liability provided under this Article, shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by such later amended Florida law.

D) FOURTH: The manner in which the Directors of the Corporation shall be elected or appointed shall be governed by the provisions of the Bylaws of the Corporation. The names and street addresses of the initial directors of the Corporation are:
