Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this *Florida Not For Profit Corporation* adopts the following amendment(s) to its Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST, The Corporation hereby revokes the existing Article III and substitutes therefor the following Article III:

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

SECOND. The Corporation hereby adds the following Article VIII:

ARTICLE VIII: DEDICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Member, Director or Officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no Member, Director or Officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the corporation. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the corporation will be turned over to (1) one or more organizations which is or are exempt as an organization or organizations described in section 501(c)(3) and section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code or (2) the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purposes.

THIRD, The remaining Articles are unchanged, and this amendment is to be effective immediately upon filing.
