Articles of Incorporation

AUG 7 P 3-14 Article of Incorporation of the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation named Bible Film Project under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article I: The name of the Corporation shall be Bible Film Project. Inc.

Article II: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is 4420 Bay Forest Lane, Fruitland Park, FL 34731. This is located in Lake County, Florida.

Article III: Said corporation is organized exclusively for the production, financing, distribution, and translation of Biblically based film for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV: Directors to the board are appointed and voted on by members of the current board of directors. This board will range in size from three to nine directors.

Article V: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial trustees of the corporation are as follows:
