The assets received and held by the Corporation subject to limitation permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational, or similar purposes, but not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of the dissolution, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more organizations that are exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (including, without limitation, Hospice of Palm Beach County Foundation, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation (the "HPBC Foundation")),
- 5. All other remaining assets of the Corporation (if any) shall be distributed in accordance with the bylaws of the Corporation to one or more organizations which are engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the Corporation and which qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (including, without limitation, the HPBC Foundation).

The undersigned officer of the Corporation hereby certifies that the Corporation has no members entitled to vote on the dissolution and that on December 21, 2015, the Board of Directors of the Corporation unanimously adopted this Plan of Distribution of Assets.
