

Articles of Incorporation of Bethel Abundant Life Ministries, Inc.



(Document Number: N08000007821)

Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Statutes sections 617.1006, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

Article III is hereby amended as follows:

This corporation is organized as a church exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes, advancing the Kingdom of God to impact communities with the gospel of Jesus Christ by establishing Apostolic Churches to promote true worship and the conversion of the un-regenerate; fostering love, fellowship and unity among the members; ministering the Word through Bible studies, conferences, retreats, and other activities; assisting other ministries of "like precious faith" in their mission to build the Kingdom of God; living and teaching the Word of God and the principles of His Kingdom by developing dynamic Evangelistic Outreach Ministries in order to reach people for Christ; teaching and preaching the concept of the Kingdom of God in order to "make disciples of all men", using all types of media; educating and ministering to the needs of the less fortunate in the community through Social Outreach Ministries that educate and empower persons challenged by spiritual and socio-economic difficulties to lift their standard of living to experience an abundant life in Christ; distributing supplies to assist persons affected during hard times, especially by disasters and other emergencies; and engaging in any other activity not prohibited to corporations under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act that is in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) taxexempt purposes.

Article IV is amended as follows:

The corporation shall not have voting members. The qualifications, duties, and method of election of directors shall be stated in the bylaws of the corporation. The corporation shall have a minimum of three (3) and no more than twelve (12) directors.

Article IX is added as follows:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an organization exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article X is added as follows:

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article XI is added as follows:

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set forth in Article III.

Article XII is added as follows:

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except that the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article XIII is added as follows:

The articles of incorporation and the bylaws of this corporation may be amended by the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting upon a four-fifths (4/5) majority vote of the members present. A quorum for the purposes of amending the articles of incorporation shall not be less than 75% of the total members.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the Amendments was July 7, 2010

THIRD: There are no members or members entitled to vote on the

amendments. The amendments were adopted by the board of

directors.
