We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of eighteen years or more, all of whom are citizens of the State of Florida, acting as incorporators of a corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Article of Incorporation for such corporation.

Article I

The name of the corporation shall be: The Genesis Project Ministries of North West Florida, Inc.

Article II

The corporation is to have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved by operation of law.

Article III

The objects purposes and business of the corporation, which is organized exclusively as a Christian, charitable and eleemosynary corporation, are: To stand as a school of mentoring, designed to provide for the physical and spiritual needs of its students through Christian, faith-based discipleship, practical, lifelong career developmental studies, counseling, teaching, and musical training, and to use media or any other method deemed viable to promote the betterment of the students. We will also provide student with the opportunity to obtain GED diplomas and experience learning from other institutes of higher learning.

(A) The corporation is a non-profit corporation. No part of the earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its member, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to make reasonable compensations for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof. No substantial part of the activities of corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The members of the corporation shall be the same persons as the Directors and shall consist of the persons named herein as Directors and such others as may be hereafter appointed by the President of the Corporation.

(A) Management: The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the Board of directors.

(B) Number and Appointment: The number of Directors constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall not be less than three (3) and not more than twenty (20).
