Article 3. Statement of Purpose

The purpose of the A New Path Christian Counseling Inc. a private, not—for—profit corporation in Winter Park, Orange County, Florida, is to facilitate effective professional mental health and counseling services that is formed and rooted in communities of faith that have a particular investment in its healing ministry. Affirms the diverse ways people may understand and experience the Divine in their lives. Is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors who, in dialogue with staff and through the Corporation's designated leadership team, establishes policy and direction for the organization. Delivers services that balance high quality with broad accessibility to all persons, regardless of their age, language, culture, lifestyle, or financial means.

Is a not-for-profit organization that sustains its service to the community through a strong and growing endowment combined with active fund-raising for current needs, appropriate contracts with community partners, and effective service revenue generation. Is staffed by skilled and credentialed clinicians whose own spiritual journeys and ties are vital parts of their professional service and who deliver effective service based upon evidence-based practices.

Is committed to bringing deep and enduring change to people and families in the Central Florida area who seek healing and guidance at the organization by providing careful assessment and effective mental health and counseling to children, adults, couples and families. Works to be a consultative resource to behavioral health providers and to religious leaders and organizations in the Central Florida area.

Seeks to discern and respond appropriately to the growing and changing needs of the people of Central Florida for effective and accessible mentall health and counseling services.

- a) A primary function of <u>A New Path Christian Counseling Inc.</u> shall be to obtain public and private monies and to act as a management corporation, serving as an intermediary between funding sources and providers of mental health services.
 - 1. The primary means to be used by A New Path Christian Counseling Inc. in achieving its purpose shall be:
 - a. To serve as a network for the provision of mental health-related social services by working with existing agencies, Mental Health Service Organizations and (CBO's), and community programs already providing such services.
 - b. To develop systems to insure the smooth and efficient Operation, continuation, and expansion of high quality services and programs.
 - c. To develop resource and training for programs staff, by working with existing community agencies and organizations whenever possible to enhance Mental health-related social services.
 - d. To conduct research and evaluation to improve Mental Health Services.
 - e. To inform and educate the residents of the counties of Orange, Osceola, Lake, Seminole and Brevard as well as its policy makers.
 - f. To formulate and implement strategies for meeting client needs.
 - 2. This Corporation shall be authorized to exercise the powers permitted not for profit corporations under Chapter 617, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, of the Florida Statutes; provided, however, that this corporations in exercising any one or more of such powers shall do so in the furtherance of the attempt purpose for which it has been organized as described in Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 8. Additional Provisions

Dissolution

- (1). In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, such dissolution shall be accordance with the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Section 617.05 of the Florida Statutes (or other applicable statutes) or, in the absence of any statutory provision, on instructions and under the procedures set forth by the Corporation.
 - (2). Upon dissolution or liquidation of this Corporation, no Members, Officers, Directors, Trustees or staff shall have any vested right, interest or privilege of, in or to the assets, functions, affairs or franchise of the Corporation, and any such funds or other assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of Sections 501 © (3) and 170 © (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal, state or local governments for a public purpose.
