## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CARL EVERETT, JR., FOUNDATION, INC.

ALLANDS R. W. O.

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation hereby associates to form a corporation (the "Corporation") not-for-profit under the Florida Not For Profit Act and other laws of the State of Florida (*Florida Statutes* Chapter 617)

## ARTICLE I Name and Address

The name of this Corporation is the Carl Everett, Jr., Foundation, Inc.

The address of this corporation is 10014 Water Works Lane, Riverview, Florida 33578 or such other address within the State of Florida as the Board of Directors may from time to time designate.

## ARTICLE II Purpose and Limitations

A. Carl Everett, Jr., Foundation, Inc., is organized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code. In carrying out such purposes, this Corporation shall have all the powers and authorities granted by statute and law, including the power and authority to accept gifts, devises and other contributions for educational and charitable purposes, to hold and administer the funds and properties received and to expend, contribute and otherwise dispose of funds or properties for educational and charitable purposes either directly or by contribution to other Section 501(c)(3) organizations organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes; provided, however, said powers and authorities shall be exercised only in furtherance of educational and charitable purposes.

The primary purposes of this Corporation are to promote the character development of disadvantaged children by supporting their involvement and participation in baseball, softball, and related athletic activities, with the goal of providing participants with positive experiences in teamwork and individual discipline, thereby enhancing their self-esteem and self reliance.

B. No part of the organization's assets will inure to the benefit of any private individual. No substantial part of the activities may include carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation [except as provided for in subsection 501(h)], or participation in or intervening in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) and political campaigns on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. ## ARTICLE XI Amendment of Articles of Incorporation
