This organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, & scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. b. C. To add value to the life of those in our community by providing night time shelter, clothing, food, and youth activities free of charge to the community. By doing this we will be able to further our exempt purpose by linking both community residents and our clients with needed resources and by eliminating barriers such as, cost, affordability, access and eligibility. For the night time shelter, they would need to be in my 6:00pm and leave by 8:00 am. The process clerk, security, and CEO would conduct activities. We could conduct the shelter out of our future building that has not yet been purchased. This is one of the main focuses of out goal to support our community. Men, women, and children will be able to stay at the shelter, and will be on a first come first serve basis starting at 6pm each day. There will be no fee for theses services. By providing the night time shelter, this will eliminate them from sleeping on the streets. We will assist in food by partnering with other organizations that provide food services, and also continue our own food drive services. Food services would be provided Monday through Friday's lunch from 11:30am-12:30pm and dinner from 5:30pm -6:30pm. We will assist in clothing that will be provided by donations, and funds by the Life Enrichment Community Center. Those who are in need of clothing will be able to receive free of charge, and will be available when the night shelter is open. Our youth activities will teach the game of football, baseball, and basketball, and will help the children of the community learn team work. These services will be conducted by athletic director, assistant director, and other helpers. There will be special events held at least once monthly. The location of these activities will vary depending on the sport but in our community park areas. We plan to provide sport activities after school and also in the summer as a sports camp. Children, boys and girls between the ages of 5 years old to 18 years of age will be placed within there age group. Again this will be at no cost.
