





ARTICLE III - SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

The purpose and powers of this corporation are to engage in and have unlimited power to do any and all lawful purposes, by all lawful powers, of a corporation not for profit pursuant to the laws of the United States and the laws of a State of Florida. The specific purpose of this institution shall be to encourage and enhance the educational experience of the children, teachers, and school administration, and in so doing, foster a sense of support, pride, and enthusiasm through the creation of family activities and volunteer based programs that support teachers, children, and parents. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the purposes of this corporation are limited to such purposes as are permitted under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VIII - SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
