Articles of Incorporation of

Defend America with Knowledge INC.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is The Primary purpose is to educate and inform the American Public as well as the Global Community on any and all contributions to the Global Community made by The United States and is citizens, The American people. To provide a venue for people to research these accomplishments and contributions and the affect they have on the world. To provide Speeches and presentations on such as well as make available this information on the internet in order to promote the positive influence America has.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
